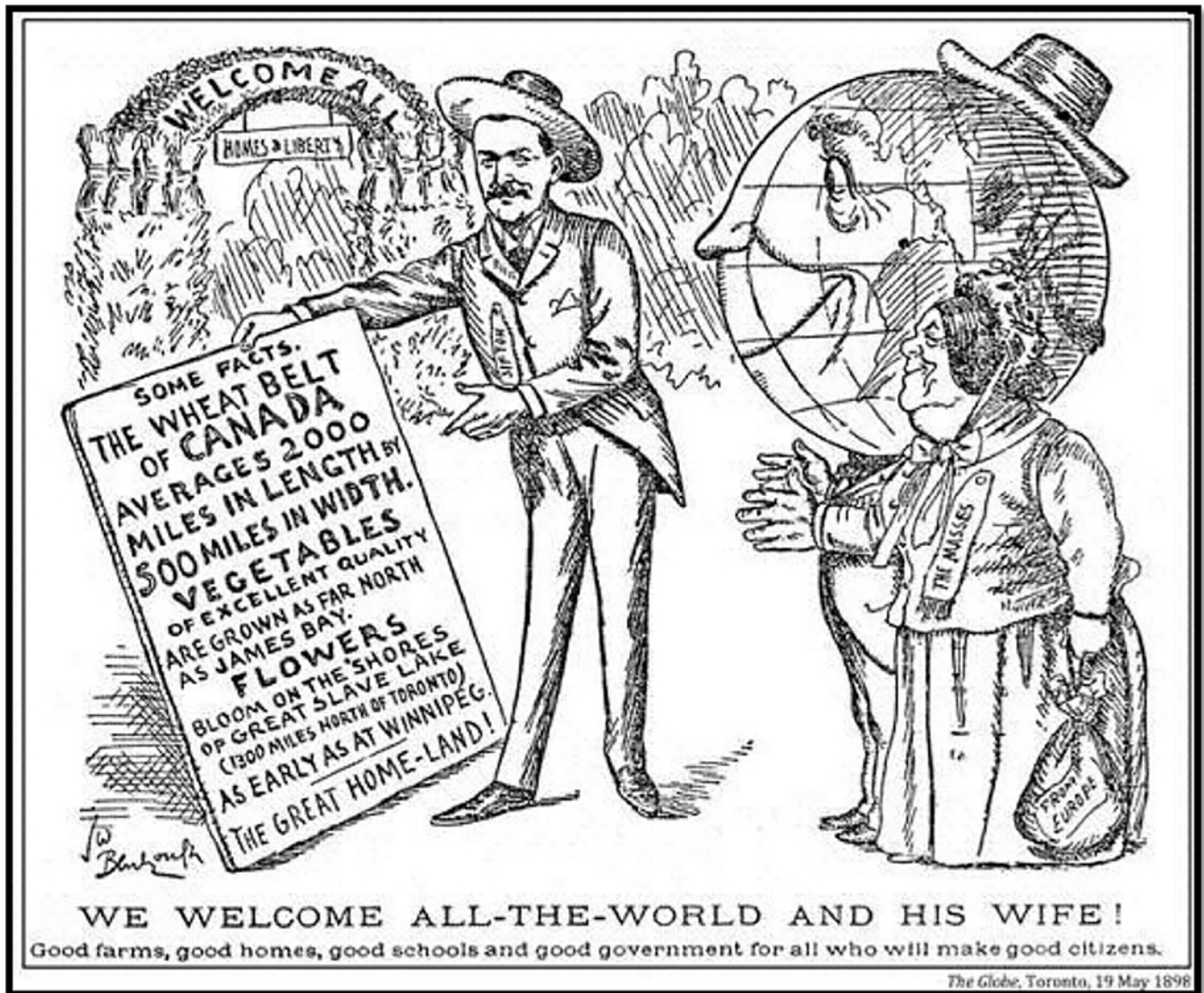

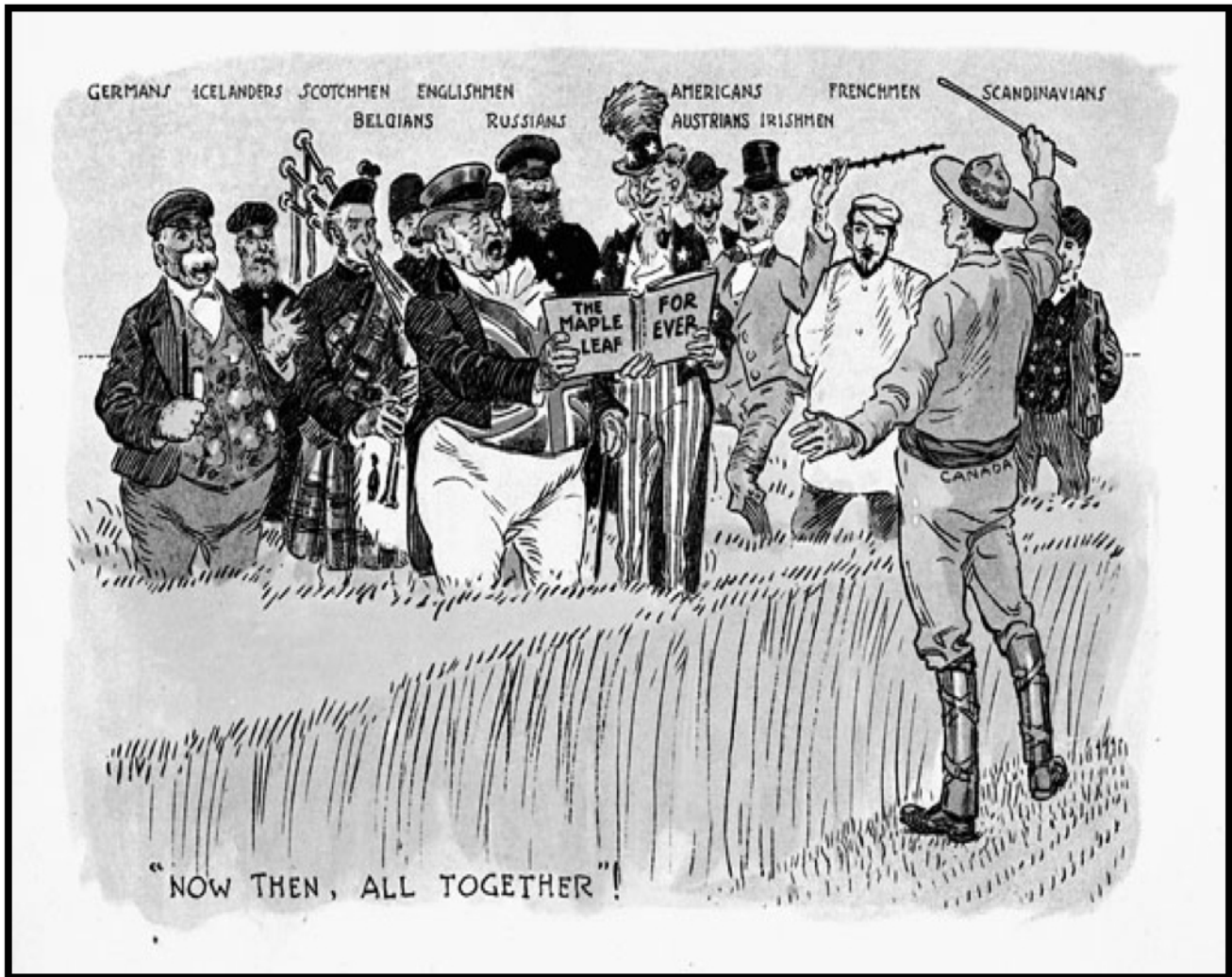

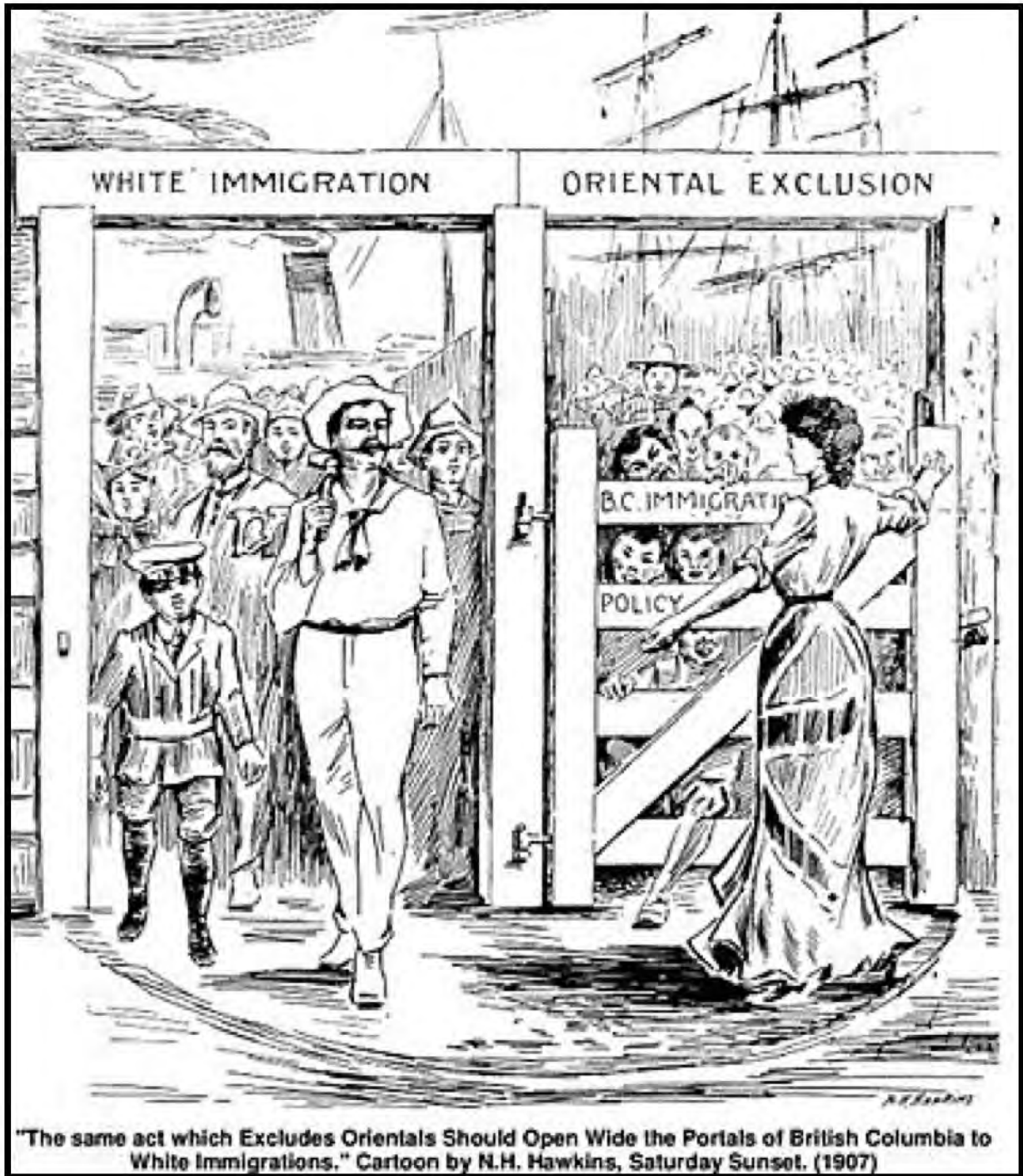


Note: One of Clifford Sifton's posters promoting Canadian immigration.

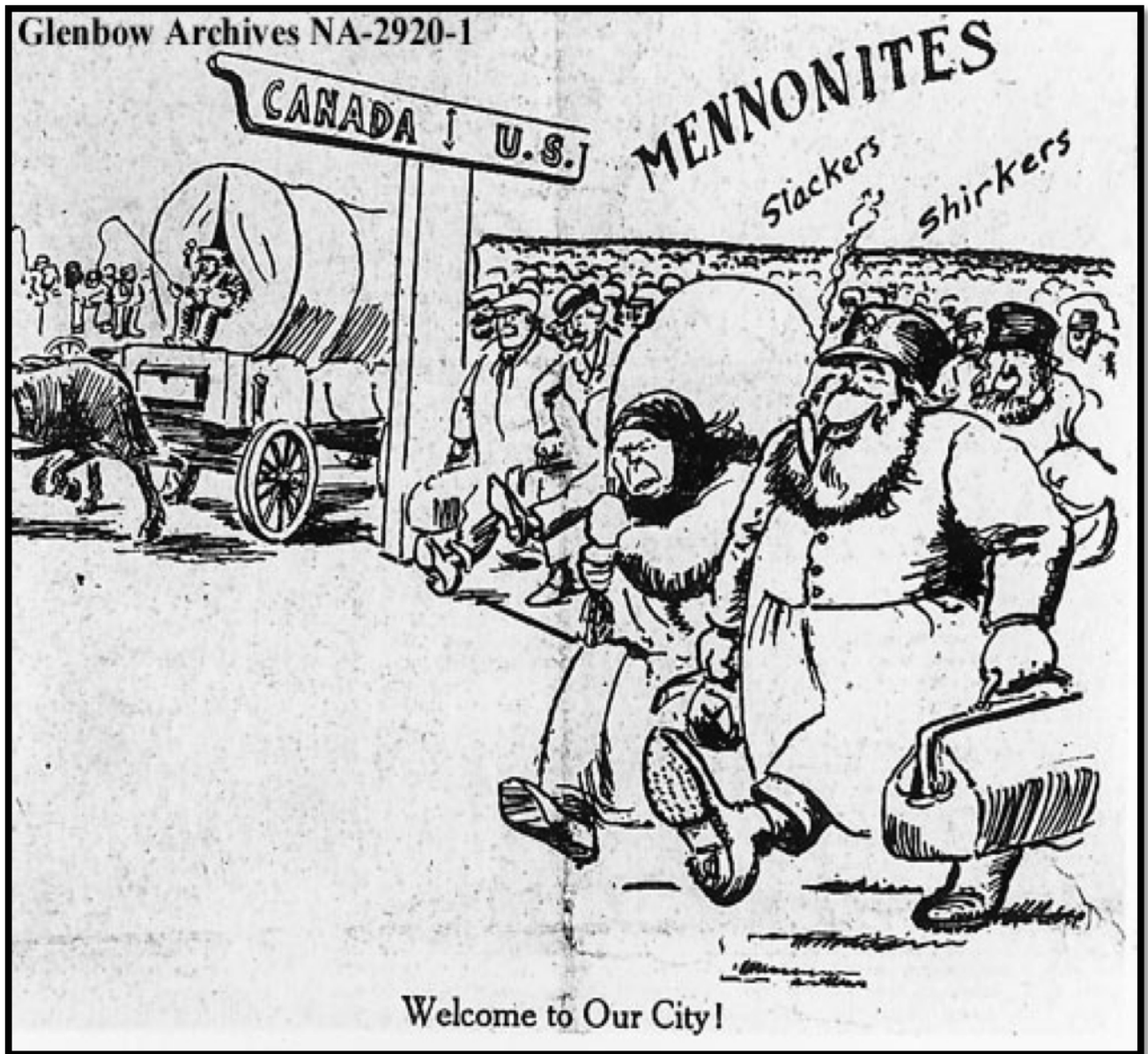
