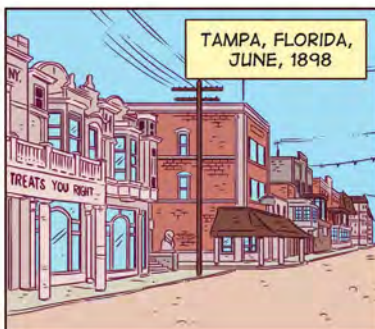

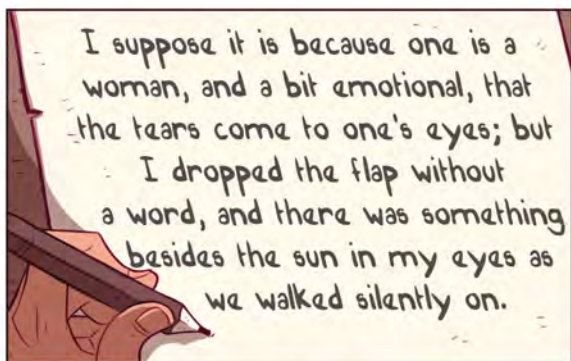

KIT COLEMAN WAS A FEARLESS JOURNALIST WHO TRAVELLED ALL OVER THE WORLD TO REPORT FOR TORONTO NEWSPAPERS. IN 1889 SHE BECAME THE FIRST FULL-TIME WOMEN'S PAGE EDITOR IN CANADA. FOR MORE THAN 20 YEARS, HER COLUMN, WOMAN'S KINGDOM, COVERED EVERYTHING FROM POLITICS TO ENTERTAINMENT.



IN 1904 SHE HELPED CREATE THE CANADIAN WOMEN'S PRESS CLUB, WHICH AIMED TO "MAINTAIN AND IMPROVE THE STATUS OF JOURNALISM AS A PROFESSION FOR WOMEN."
